

The proposed project is located in the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida (St. Lucie County). The proposed project would extend the Crosstown Parkway from Manth Lane on the west, across the North Fork St. Lucie River to U.S. 1 on the east, a distance of approximately 2 miles. Alternatives under consideration include the No Build Alternative, transportation systems management alternatives, and multiple build alternatives that provide a river crossing on a new alignment.
